#### **DETAILS**


- Two elevated walkway bridges connect the north side building to The Bay at the west end and to the MTS Center at the east
- Portage Place is a four-level center located in the heart of Downtown Winnipeg with over 100 shops and services, underground parking and an entertainment level all under one roof
- The entertainment level features Prairie Theatre Exchange (live theatre)
- The 3rd and 4th office level is home to Investors Group, Canadian Foodgrains Bank Association, Independent Living and The Family Centre
- Opened in 1987
- Total building area: 497,561 sf
- Common area: 140,407 sf
- Number of floors: 4
- Parking stalls: 1,000+ (underground parkade)

- \$3B+ has been invested in downtown since 2005
- 26 BOMA BEST/Green Globes certified buildings
- 210 free WIFI locations
- Over 200,000 Twitter followers of downtown

- Over 16,000 people live downtown
- \$647 million+ is spent by tourists each year
- There are 4 million annual visits to The Forks

- 16 major public art installations, adding over \$1.8 million of investment downtown
- Cycling is up 60% in Winnipeg since 2009, 6,200 people commute downtown by bicycle

- 90% of people said they feel safe downtown during the day, a 33% increase from 2007





